Hutcherson was vital to South Carolina's running game in 2020. South Carolina running back Kevin Harris rushed for 1,000 yards. South Carolina hadn't rushed for 1,000 yards since 2013. Hutcherson played tackle and guard at South Carolina.

Hutcherson went undrafted in 2021 and eventually signed with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers. Unfortunately, Hutcherson tore his ACL in a 2021 preseason game against the Bengals. <u>Hutcherson</u> was waived by the Buccaneers on August 29, 2022. The Bucs' offensive line had depth and Hutcherson wasn't going to be a starter on the offensive line.

Sadarius Hutcherson's story is unique for many reasons. Despite having a strong collegiate career Hutcherson didn't have success in the NFL.
